**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE RELEASE  
OF LAND-CASH MONIES**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Sugar Grove, Illinois requires developers to make land or cash contributions which the Village in turn holds and makes available for other governmental bodies which are affected by the development; and

**WHEREAS**, such contributions inure to the benefit of certain governmental bodies; and

**WHEREAS**, the **Sugar Grove Park District** is one such governmental body eligible to benefit from said contributions and is seeking disbursement of said funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds shall be used to the extent permitted by law in one of the following ways:

- To purchase park and recreation land.
- To develop or improve acquired or existing park land and amenities.
- To purchase, construct or renovate

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SUGAR GROVE PARK DISTRICT, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** that this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.

I, Steven Siebert, in my official capacity as President of the Board of the Sugar Grove Park District; on oath affirm, swear, and state as follows:

1. The Board of the Sugar Grove Park District has adopted by official action on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2004 a resolution requesting the Village of Sugar Grove to release \$ 100,000.00 of the monies held by the Village, which were received by virtue of the Sugar Grove Land/Cash Ordinance, or by virtue of impact fees collected pursuant to an annexation agreement, for park purposes on account of various residential subdivision(s) in Sugar Grove.
2. The Board has further resolved to hold the Village of Sugar Grove, and its officials, employees and agents harmless, and to indemnify and defend the Village and its officials, employees and agents for any and all claims of any kind (including reasonable attorneys fees and costs), and whether in tort, contract, or otherwise, brought against the Village, its officials, employees and agents by developers, landowners, or any other person arising out of the collection of land/cash funds by the Village or the use of land/cash funds by the Park District after these funds have been disbursed by the Village to the District. A certified copy of this resolution is attached, and said resolution has not been amended or repealed.
3. These funds shall be used to the extent permitted by law in one of the following ways:
  - To purchase park and recreation land.
  - To develop or improve acquired or existing park land and amenities.
  - To purchase, construct or renovate recreational facilities.

Such acquisitions and improvements will be available to serve residents of the subdivision(s) and/or are necessary to meet service needs created by the development of the subdivision(s).
